Bookshare Ireland is the largest accessible library in the country available for all people with visual impairment or print disabilities. **The service is available to students with dyslexia.** Launched in November 2019, it is a partnership between the National Council of the Blind and the Department of Education and Skills. It is a free service for those who qualify with over half a million books, which are available in a range of formats including audio, digital Braille, Word, and PDF.

Revision packs for Science, Geography and French designed for students with dyslexia

Oaka www.oakabooks.co.uk is a UK publishing company which was set up because there were no text books with which the dyslexic daughter of its founders found easy to learn from. The Oaka System helps visual learners retain focus and interest. The Science, Geography and French packs are at KS3 level which is for 11 to 14 year olds. The Science pack has been designed specifically for **dyslexic pupils, written by science teachers and SEN specialists**. There are 23 science topic packs. All are fully illustrated and come complete with a topic booklet, a booklet for students to write their own notes as well as a fun revision game with 42 Q&A cards.

While based on the UK curriculum, much is relevant to Irish students.
