Revision packs for Science, Geography and French designed for students with dyslexia

Oaka www.oakabooks.co.uk. is a UK publishing company which was set up because there were no text books with which the dyslexic daughter of its founders found easy to learn from. The Oaka System helps visual learners retain focus and interest. The Science, Geography and French packs are at KS3 level which is for 11 to 14 year olds. The Science pack has been designed specifically for dyslexic pupils, written by science teachers and SEN specialists. There are 23 science topic packs. They also have an Essay Writing Pack.
